SUBJECT; ARMY REIMBURSABLE POLICY (ARP)

A. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE INSTRUCTION (DODI) NUMBER 4000.19 DATED
AUGUST 9, 1995, SUBJ: INTERSERVICE AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL SUPPORT.

B. ARMY REIMBURSABLE POLICY ISSUED MAY 19, 1995 BY THE ASSISTANT
SECRETARY OF THE ARMY FOR FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND COMPTROLLER.

C. SAFM-BUR MSG DTG 211530ZDEC95, SUBJ: REVISIONS TO THE ARMY
REIMBURSABLE POLICY (ARP).

1. PURPOSE. HQDA HAS MADE SEVERAL RECENT DECISIONS ON THE ARP.
THESE DECISIONS AND THEIR IMPACTS ARE ADDRESSED IN THIS MESSAGE.

2. POLICY EXCEPTIONS.

A. ARMY WORKING CAPITAL FUND (AWCF) INSTALLATIONS. AWCF
INSTALLATIONS AND THEIR TENANTS ARE EXCLUDED FROM THIS POLICY
MESSAGE. AWCF INSTALLATIONS ARE TO CONTINUE TO REFLECT AND CHARGE
TOTAL BASE SUPPORT COSTS IN THEIR RATES TO TENANTS, SINCE BASE
SUPPORT IS A CHARTERED PRIMARY MISSION.

B. CORPS OF ENGINEERS (COE) REVOLVING FUND. THE ARMY COE REVOLVING
FUND IS EXCLUDED FROM THIS POLICY. THE COE WILL CONTINUE TO CHARGE
CUSTOMERS TOTAL COSTS FOR DESIGN AND ADMINISTRATION SERVICES
ASSOCIATED WITH INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS.

C. ARMY FAMILY HOUSING OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE (AFHO). THE AFHO
ACCOUNT IS EXCLUDED FROM THIS POLICY. ARMY FAMILY HOUSING WILL
CONTINUE TO REIMBURSE THE INSTALLATION FOR ALL DIRECT SUPPORT;
REIMBURSE THE INSTALLATION FOR INDIRECT SUPPORT AT THOSE LOCATIONS
WHERE REIMBURSEMENT IS CURRENTLY BEING MADE; AND RECEIVE INDIRECT
SUPPORT ON A NONREIMBURSABLE BASIS AT THOSE LOCATIONS WHERE NO
REIMBURSEMENT IS CURRENTLY BEING MADE.

3. INTERCOMMAND REIMBURSABLE SUPPORT. THE "INTERCOMMAND REIMBURSABLE SUPPORT" PORTION OF THE ARP ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED FOR IMPLEMENTATION ON OCTOBER 1, 1998 (FY99) WILL NOT BE IMPLEMENTED. THE TERM "INTERCOMMAND" REFERS TO AN ARMY TENANT I.E. FROM A DIFFERENT ARMY COMMAND/MACOM THAN THE HOST BUT HAS THE SAME APPROPRIATION AS THE HOST. THIS DECISION IS BASED ON AN AAA SURVEY OF SEVERAL ARMY INSTALLATIONS. THE AAA SURVEY CONCLUDES THAT THE COST OF IMPLEMENTING AND SUSTAINING INTERCOMMAND SUPPORT, ALONG WITH THE LACK OF A COST ACCOUNTING SYSTEM, OUTWEIGHS THE ASSUMED BENEFIT OF TENANTS KNOWING THEIR BASE SUPPORT COSTS AND BEING ABLE TO INFLUENCE THOSE COSTS.

4. INTRA-ARMY APPROPRIATION REIMBURSABLE SUPPORT. THE "INTRA-ARMY REIMBURSABLE SUPPORT" PORTION OF THE ARP, CURRENTLY IN EFFECT, IS RESCINDED. "INTRA-ARMY" REFERS TO ARMY TENANTS AND HOSTS THAT ARE FUNDED BY DIFFERENT APPROPRIATIONS (I.E., ARMY RESERVE, NATIONAL GUARD, RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, TESTING AND EVALUATION, ETC.).

5. INTERSERVICE, INTERDEPARTMENTAL, AND INTERAGENCY REIMBURSABLE BASE SUPPORT. THE INTERSERVICE, INTERDEPARTMENTAL, AND INTERAGENCY REIMBURSABLE BASE SUPPORT PORTION OF THE ARP REMAINS IN EFFECT. REIMBURSEMENT IS LIMITED TO INCREMENTAL COSTS (E.G., SPECIFIED SUPPORT FOR A NON-ARMY TENANT INCREASES THE HOSTS' DIRECT COSTS) CONSISTENT WITH REF A. ALL ARMY HOSTS SHOULD ALREADY HAVE SUPPORT AGREEMENTS (SA) IN PLACE WITH THESE TENANTS.

6. BASE SUPPORT TO ARMY TENANTS.

A. STANDARD LEVEL OF SUPPORT. ARMY INSTALLATIONS ARE TO ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE A STANDARD LEVEL OF BASE SUPPORT TO ALL ARMY TENANTS. THIS DOES NOT PREVENT THE HOST INSTALLATION FROM ADJUSTING STANDARD BASE SUPPORT LEVELS TO ITS TENANTS TO MEET REDUCED RESOURCE LEVELS. HOWEVER, THE HOST WILL NOT ASSESS TENANTS A DISPROPORTIONATE REDUCTION IN SUPPORT.

B. SUPPORT ABOVE STANDARD. ARMY TENANTS ARE EXPECTED TO REIMBURSE THE HOST FOR SERVICES REQUESTED ABOVE STANDARD LEVELS.

7. EXISTING SA'S

A. ARMY TENANTS WITH SAME APPROPRIATION AS HOST. ALL EXISTING SA'S BETWEEN ARMY TENANTS (ALL ACTIVITIES RECEIVING BASE SUPPORT INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION COMMANDER) AND HOSTS (GARRISON COMMANDER) ARE TO TERMINATE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1999. ARMY TENANTS, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THEIR ARMY HOST, WILL TRANSFER THE ESTIMATED STANDARD LEVELS OF SUPPORT TO THE HOST DURING THE FY 00-04 POM ON A COORDINATED SCHEDULE

8. ONCE THIS TRANSFER TAKES PLACE THE TENANT WILL ONLY REIMBURSE THE HOST FOR BASE SUPPORT SERVICES ABOVE STANDARD LEVELS.

B. ARMY TENANTS WITH DIFFERENT APPROPRIATION THAN HOST. ALL EXISTING SA'S BETWEEN ARMY TENANTS (ALL ACTIVITIES RECEIVING BASE SUPPORT INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION COMMANDER) AND HOSTS (GARRISON COMMANDER) ARE TO TERMINATE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1999. ARMY TENANTS, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THEIR ARMY HOST, WILL TRANSFER THE ESTIMATED STANDARD LEVELS OF SUPPORT TO THE HOST DURING THE FY 00-04 POM ON A COORDINATED SCHEDULE 8. ONCE THIS TRANSFER TAKES PLACE THE TENANT WILL ONLY REIMBURSE THE HOST FOR BASE SUPPORT SERVICES ABOVE STANDARD LEVELS.

C. NON-ARMY TENANTS (E.G., INTERSERVICE, INTERDEPARTMENTAL, AND INTERAGENCY ACTIVITIES). SA'S MUST COMPLY WITH THE DODI, REF A. REIMBURSEMENT IS LIMITED TO INCREMENTAL COSTS (E.G., SPECIFIED SUPPORT FOR A TENANT INCREASES THE HOSTS' DIRECT COSTS). THESE SA'S SHOULD ALREADY BE IN PLACE.

8. OTHER ACTIONS.

A. AN ACTIVE ARMY TENANT ON AN ARMY RESERVE OR AN ARMY NATIONAL GUARD INSTALLATION; AN ARMY RESERVE TENANT ON AN ACTIVE ARMY OR AN ARMY NATIONAL GUARD INSTALLATION; AN ARMY NATIONAL GUARD TENANT ON AN ACTIVE ARMY, OR AN ARMY RESERVE INSTALLATION. ALL ARMY HOSTS (BE THEY ACTIVE, RESERVE OR NATIONAL GUARD) ARE TO STOP BILLING ACTIVE ARMY, ARMY RESERVE AND ARMY NATIONAL GUARD TENANTS LOCATED "ON THE INSTALLATION" FOR STANDARD LEVELS OF BASE SUPPORT ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1999. THE ACTIVE ARMY, ARMY RESERVE AND ARMY NATIONAL GUARD TENANTS' FUNDS FOR STANDARD LEVELS OF BASE SUPPORT ARE TO BE TRANSFERRED TO THE ARMY HOST DURING THE FY 00-04 POM. ONCE THE FUNDS ARE TRANSFERRED, THE ACTIVE ARMY, ARMY RESERVE AND ARMY NATIONAL GUARD TENANT WILL NO LONGER BE BILLED FOR STANDARD LEVELS OF SUPPORT, BUT WILL REIMBURSE FOR ANY ABOVE STANDARD SUPPORT THEY REQUIRE.

B. REIMBURSEMENT FOR INTRA-ARMY MILITARY PERSONNEL. A REVIEW INTO THE LEGALITY OF ARMY COMPONENTS (AC, RESERVE, AND GUARD) REIMBURSING EACH OTHER FOR TRAINING SERVICES PROVIDED BY MILITARY PERSONNEL HAS BEEN ONGOING FOR SOME TIME. OSD ACCOUNTING POLICY, PERSONNEL AND THE ARMY GENERAL COUNSEL FOR FISCAL MATTERS RECENTLY STATED THAT SUCH REIMBURSEMENT CAN BE PERFORMED. HQDA IS CURRENTLY REVIEWING IMPLEMENTATION OPTIONS. MILITARY PAY REIMBURSEMENT IS BASED ON THE REIMBURSABLE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES OF REF B. A DECISION ON IMPLEMENTING A POLICY ON MILITARY PAY REIMBURSEMENT FOR TRAINING WILL BE FORTHCOMING IN THE UPDATE TO REF B.

9. OFF-POST CUSTOMERS.

A. ALL ARMY OFF-POST CUSTOMERS RECEIVING RECURRING AND/OR AD HOC BASE SUPPORT (E.G., MEPCOM, RECRUITING CMD, NATIONAL GUARD, AND RESERVE SHOP SMART AND ANNUAL TRAINING, BASOPS TRANSITIONS PROGRAMS; ETC.) WILL CONTINUE TO REIMBURSE FOR THEIR BASE SUPPORT SERVICES. THESE ARMY OFF-POST CUSTOMERS NEED ONLY USE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND/OR MIPR FOR SUCH REIMBURSABLE SUPPORT.

B. CADET COMMAND REIMBURSES ONLY FOR ABOVE STANDARD LEVEL OF SUPPORT.
