SUBJECT: 26<sup>th</sup> ASG Command Policy Memorandum 16, Urinalysis Testing Procedure

1. Reference AR 600-85, Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP), 1 Oct 01.
2. It is the policy of the 26<sup>th</sup> Area Support Group to support the effective utilization of the urinalysis program as a deterrent to illegal drug abuse. Commanders in the 26<sup>th</sup> ASG will ensure that random testing is carried out in a fashion, which denies predictability. All units are expected to achieve the USAREUR 200% testing goal.
3. The urinalysis program is effective only to the extent that commanders swiftly and severely discipline identified drug abusers. It is the 26<sup>th</sup> ASG policy that commanders will react firmly and expeditiously to all incidents of illegal drug use. The 26<sup>th</sup> ASG Army Substance Abuse Program will assist commanders in developing and monitoring a successful urinalysis program.
